# History

## Funding:

- FY 2014 Carryover \$165,301
  - No additional allocation was provided in FY 2015
  - Current balance as of November 2014 - \$140,615
- 
- Traffic Calming Policy adopted by Council November 2013

# Completed Projects

## ▪ Speed Cushions:

- Stewart Drive – 2 locations with 3 cushions each - \$3600
- Riverside HOA – 3 pairs of cushions installed to supplement current traffic calming measures:
  - Mountainbrook Way – 2 locations - \$2400
  - Edgewater Trail – 1 location - \$1200
- Mitchell Rd – 4 locations with 2 cushions each - \$4800

\*All above projects were 50% funded by the neighborhoods and were completed prior to the 2014/2015 school year.

## ▪ Neighborhood Self-improvement Program:

- Huntcliff HOA – Added a double yellow line to River Run - \$1260

\*project funded 100% by HOA


# Pending Projects

4

- Londonberry Neighborhood
  - Neighborhood does not have a HOA board, petition process is ongoing
  - Neighborhood is unable to get support with speed cushion installation
  - Staff has met with neighborhood traffic calming committee to discuss alternative designs and proper placement of calming devices, such as choker islands, splitter islands, etc.
  - Current opinion of cost for project is \$175,000 with a required neighborhood contribution of 50% of the project cost.
