ITEM: Approval for the Mayor to sign the List of Roadways for submittal to the Georgia Department of Transportation for funding under the Fiscal Year 2019 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Council approve the attached list of streets for consideration by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) for the Fiscal Year 2019 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG).

Background:

On an annual basis GDOT allows submissions by local governments for funding of needed projects within city, county or state rights-of-way. In furtherance of Operation Pave On, the Public Works Department has compiled a list of roads in need of resurfacing to submit to GDOT for funding under this Grant. The prioritized project list is due to GDOT by December 31, 2018.

Discussion:

The attached list represents approximately 4.17 miles of roads that are in need of resurfacing. The list was compiled using the 2018 pavement condition index (PCI). The streets to be submitted represent those with low PCI scores within the City's network and those that are logical to complete in conjunction with the lower ranked streets.

There is a required 30% match to the LMIG. The City's LMIG distribution is \$906,447.49. The estimated amount to complete this work which includes all items necessary to complete the resurfacing of these roads is \$1,220,517.00. It is recommended that the City submit work in excess of the necessary amount to insure expenditure of the entire grant plus the required 30%.

If the City chooses to submit these roads, the financial impact to the City will be the 30% required match of \$271,934.25, plus any funds that may be above and beyond that amount to complete the submitted list.
