A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, THE TAX COMMISSIONER OF FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA FOR THE BILLING AND COLLECTION OF TAXES AND FEES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND ATTEST SAID AMENDMENT, RESPECTIVELY

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs (“City”) entered into an agreement with Fulton County and the Fulton County Tax Commissioner on February 1, 2006, for the billing and collection of certain taxes and fees (“Current Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Current Agreement will expire effective December 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find it to be in the best interest of the City of Sandy Springs to amend the Current Agreement at Section IV to provide for an extension of its term for an additional ten (10) years to December 1, 2025, or the conclusion of the current Tax Commissioner’s last term of office as Tax Commissioner of Fulton County, whichever occurs first, subject to the right of the City or the Tax Commissioner to notify the other of its intent to terminate; and

WHEREAS, all other provisions of the Current Agreement remain unchanged; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to amend the Current Agreement as provided in the First Amendment to the Agreement between Fulton County, Georgia, the Tax Commissioner of Fulton County, Georgia and the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia for the Billing and Collection of Taxes and Fees, a copy of which is attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs while in Regular Session on November 17, 2015, as follows:


1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and attest, respectively, the First Amendment to the Agreement between Fulton County, Georgia, the Tax Commissioner of Fulton County, Georgia and the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia for the Billing and Collection of Taxes and Fees (“Amendment”); and
2. That the aforementioned Amendment is attached hereto and specifically made a part hereof; and
3. That this Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
