A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE CITY'S TITLE VI POLICY TO PROVIDE MONITORING OF TITLE VI COMPLIANCE ACTIVITIES AND COMPLAINT PROCESSING IN ALL CITY PROGRAMS THAT RECEIVE FEDERAL FUNDING

WHEREAS, from time to time the City receives federal grants to fund various City projects; and

WHEREAS, agencies receiving federal grants must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act; and

WHEREAS, agencies receiving federal grants must cause their contractors and any sub-recipients of federal funds to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish policy and procedures to provide monitoring of Title VI compliance activities and complaint processing in all City programs that receive federal funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, while in regular session on July 7, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. as follows:

1. The Title VI Policy shall be established, effective immediately, to provide that the City and its sub-recipients of federal funds will not discriminate in anyway against an individual in any program or activity that is conducted with federal funds; and
2. This Title VI Policy will express the City's commitment to the nondiscrimination provisions of Title VI; and
3. This Title VI Policy will establish process and procedures to appropriately address complaints of discrimination relative to Title VI;
4. This Title VI Policy will express the City's commitment to provide quality services to all citizens, including those who have limited ability to read, speak, write, or understand English; and
5. This Title VI Policy will be circulated throughout the City government and general public.


