**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THAT THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ZONING CASES  
ALLOWED TO BE CONSIDERED EACH MONTH SHALL BE CAPPED AT FIVE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs is beginning a process of developing a new Zoning Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the city staff, the Planning Commission and the Mayor and City Council are committed to a significant number of meetings during the process of development of the new ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the number of zoning cases considered each month greatly impacts the time of the staff, boards, and elected officials; and

**WHEREAS**, the current maximum cases to be processed is limited to seven by City Council resolution.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs that the maximum number of zoning cases allowed each month shall be capped at five, of which only one may involve a Development of Regional Impact (DRI). Cases will be processed in the order received and if more than five, then those shall be scheduled for the following meeting.
