**RESOLUTION TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION  
TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 24, 2016 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, on March 29, 2016, City Council passed an ordinance (“Ordinance”) calling for a Special Election to fill the Council seat for the City of Sandy Springs left vacant by District 3 Council member Graham McDonald; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ordinance established the date and call of such Special Election to be May 24, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ordinance provided in Section 3 that advance voting for the Special Election will take place Monday, May 2, 2016, through Friday, May 20, 2016, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Fulton County North Fulton Annex, 7741 Roswell Road, Sandy Springs, Georgia; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council desires to extend advance voting for the Special Election to include one (1) Saturday for the convenience of Sandy Springs citizens and further desires to amend the Ordinance to so provide.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS THAT:**

Section 3 of the Ordinance is hereby deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof shall be substituted the following language:

**“Section 3:** Notice is hereby given that advance voting for the 2016 Special Election will take place Monday, May 2, 2016, through Friday, May 20, 2016, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., and on Saturday, May 14, 2016, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., at the Fulton County North Fulton Annex, 7741 Roswell Road, Sandy Springs, Georgia.”

All other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


