A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN APPLICATION SUBMISSION TO THE FY2016  
EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) GRANT  
PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program (“JAG”) of the Office of Justice Programs provides funding to support all components of the criminal justice system, ranging from multijurisdictional task forces to crime prevention and domestic violence programs, courts, corrections, treatment, and justice information sharing initiatives; and

WHEREAS, JAG has notified the City of Sandy Springs it is eligible to receive a grant award of \$15,894 for eligible requests; and

WHEREAS, the Sandy Springs Police Department is in need of purchasing a second recon throw-bot to assist in reconnaissance and tactical operations; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of a reconnaissance mini-robot is an eligible cost under the JAG grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, while in regular session on June 21, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. as follows:

That the City of Sandy Springs City Council hereby approves the application submission to the FY2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Grant Program, requesting funding for a mini-robot for use by the Sandy Springs Police Department.
