

How does anything on Roswell Rd South of Glen Ridge Dr. meet any requirements? This area is affluent and the City of Sandy Spring is working to remove any type of "Low Income" housing along this route as it is considered a

“threat” to local residences who are neither low income nor immigrant.

Does anything meet a greater need in this corridor than the intersection at Long Island Dr. and Roswell Rd which was glossed over by a crosswalk away from the intersection and little used by residents? Residents in the apartment complex at that 3 way intersection are still walking across the road in the middle of the block and at the intersection not further south to the very inconvenient crossing and light put in place. It's obvious the red light for crossing is a red light just like the one you denied at the intersection due to the curve in the road. Unless there is something magically different between a crosswalk red light across the road and an intersection red light across the road I'm unaware of.

Is the City of Sandy Springs OK if founders of political organizations in Washington D.C. with SS residence who's annual income is more than the City Budget begin challenging you in court on such issues?

Lastly, what roads are earmarked for widening (fit hud grant program) that are the primary “cut thru” from East Cobb? Currently, PowersFerry/Wiecua/Long Island/MtParan/Riverside are all over burdened and continuing to receive “In Fill” development greater than the existing housing it's being placed in the middle of. Without one or more of these roads and some others being widened stops signs with 53 cars between two stops is just going to increase.
