AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA TO AMEND CHAPTER 38 – Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs by adding to Division 1 of Article III on Offenses Involving Public Peace, Order and Safety, a provision restricting the hours during which consumer fireworks may be lawfully discharged or ignited

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia that Chapter 38 of the Code of the City of Sandy Springs (the “Code”) is hereby amended by adding the following Section 38-64 to Division 1 of Article III on Offenses Involving Public Peace, Order and Safety:


“Sec. 38-64. Consumer Fireworks – restrictions.

It shall be unlawful for a person to ignite or discharge, or cause to be ignited or discharged, any consumer fireworks on any day before 10:00 A.M. and after 9:00 P.M.; provided, however, it shall be lawful after the time of 9:00 P.M. and up to and including the time of 11:59 P.M. on January 1, July 3, July 4, and December 31 of each year and on January 1 of each year beginning at the time of 12:00 Midnight and up to and including the ending time of 1:00 A.M.”


