A RESOLUTION TO ELIMINATE ADVERTISING HERETOFORE RELATED TO
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, when the City of Sandy Springs came into being, existing procedures were carried over from those followed by Fulton County; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Mayor and City Council that one of the requirements carried over relating to alcoholic beverage license applications was to require advertising of the filing of the application and its scheduled hearing before City Council; and

WHEREAS, there is no state statute requiring this advertising and the attendant publication costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

There shall be no further requirement for advertising of the filing of an application for an alcoholic beverage license in the City of Sandy Springs and its scheduled hearing before City Council. All costs related thereto shall be deducted from the alcoholic beverage license application fees.

This Resolution shall be effective as of July 1, 2017.


