A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY OF A FORD F150 TRUCK TO BE USED BY THE CITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT'S CITIZENS ON PATROL UNIT FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PURPOSES, AND TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN TO EFFECTUATE THE TRANSFER OF SAID GIFT

WHEREAS, Cox Enterprises, a leading communications, media and automotive services company headquartered in Sandy Springs, desires to donate a 2017 Ford F150 Truck to the City's Police Department ("PD") to advance the public safety of the City's citizens; and

WHEREAS, the truck selected for donation to the City is a Ford F150 4X4 truck; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated the Truck will be used by PD's Citizens on Patrol Unit for the following purposes, among others: patrolling neighborhoods and city streets as a visible deterrent to criminal activity; assisting stranded motorists; handicap parking enforcement; traffic direction on accident scenes; assisting with large scale public events; and providing assistance during times of inclement weather or other emergency situations in the City; and

WHEREAS, the retail cost of the Truck is \$38,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Truck requires normal scheduled maintenance and fuel; and

WHEREAS, the only cost to the City in connection with the Truck is for installing a police radio, emergency lights and COPs vehicle graphics; and

WHEREAS, PD desires that the City accept the Truck to be used by the Citizens on Patrol Unit for public safety purposes described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs that:

1. The City does hereby accept the generous gift of Cox Enterprises to the City of the Truck, to be used by the Sandy Springs Police Department's COPs Unit for public safety purposes; and
2. The City expresses its appreciation to Cox Enterprises for its interest in the public safety of the City's citizens; and
3. The Mayor is hereby designated and authorized to execute and deliver, and the City Clerk is hereby designated and authorized to attest, such documents as may be required, and to do all things necessary and proper to effectuate the intent of this resolution.


