A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE FIRST EXTENSION OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES BETWEEN FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA

WHEREAS, the current intergovernmental agreement for the provision of animal control services between Fulton County, Georgia and Sandy Springs, Georgia is due to terminate on June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County government has proposed to continue services under the current intergovernmental agreement through December 31, 2017; and


WHEREAS, during the extended period of the intergovernmental agreement, the estimated share of the total cost to the City of Sandy Springs will remain unchanged.

That the Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to accept the first extension of the intergovernmental agreement for the provision of animal control services between Fulton County, Georgia and Sandy Springs, Georgia, as more particularly described herein. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any documents in the furtherance of this Resolution, subject to approval by Legal and Finance.


