**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AWARD OF CONTRACT IN CONNECTION WITH  
THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL, RFP # 18-001, TRAFFIC  
SIGNAL MAINTENANCE SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs (“City”) currently has a contract with a vendor for traffic signal maintenance services (“Current Contract”), which will expire June 30, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, in anticipation of the expiration of the Current Contract, the City issued its Request for Proposal, RFP # 18-001, Traffic Signal Maintenance Services, dated December 14, 2016 (“RFP”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City received proposals from various vendors in response to the RFP (“Proposals”); and

**WHEREAS**, Proposals were evaluated by evaluation panels and by the Source Selection Evaluation Team (“SSET”), pursuant to the process described in the RFP and consistent with the criteria established therein, to determine the best overall value for the City and its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, as the result of its evaluation, the SSET has provided its Source Selection Evaluation Memorandum, in the form attached to this resolution, presenting the results of its evaluation for Traffic Signal Maintenance Services and recommending: (a) GTG Traffic Signals shall receive a contract award for one (1) year, beginning July 1, 2017, in the amount of \$807,968.17, with the option of annual renewals not to exceed five (5) years and a “not-to-exceed” three percent (3%) annual escalator; and (b) GTG Traffic Signals shall begin a phase-in period beginning no later than June 7, 2017, without additional cost to the City; and


**WHEREAS**, the City desires to make such award based on the recommendations of the SSET consistent with the attached Source Selection Evaluation Memorandum.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, while in Regular session on June 6, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. as follows:

1. GTG Traffic Signals is hereby awarded a contract for Traffic Signal Maintenance Services pursuant to the terms of the RFP for one (1) year, beginning July 1, 2017, in the amount of \$807,968.17, with the option of annual renewals not to exceed five (5) years and a “not-to-exceed” three percent (3%) annual escalator, subject to termination for convenience of the City; and
2. GTG Traffic Signals shall begin a phase-in period beginning no later than June 7, 2017, without additional cost to the City; and
3. The City Manager and appropriate authorized City officials are hereby authorized to execute the contract for Traffic Signal Maintenance Services and to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
