**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE 2017 ASSESSMENT OF
FAIR HOUSING FOR THE CDBG PROGRAM TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF
HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT**

WHEREAS, since 1974 the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) has been an important federal resource for cities to assist their low- and moderate-income communities, eliminate slums and blight, and address urgent needs; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared its 2017 Assessment of Fair Housing per HUD requirement; and

WHEREAS, the City held two public hearings on June 6, 2017 and September 19, 2017, to provide an opportunity for Sandy Springs' residents to comment on the City's analysis; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised the draft 2017 Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing for a 30-day public comment period from July 20, 2017, through August 20, 2017; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires that the 2017 Assessment of Fair Housing be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

NOW, THEREFORE, to accomplish the foregoing, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, pursuant to their authority, do hereby approve the 2017 Assessment of Fair Housing.

By passage of this resolution, the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council authorizes submission of the 2017 Assessment of Fair Housing, the execution of the CDBG agreement or other necessary program documents, and the provision of an original copy of this resolution to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the purposes described in this resolution.


