A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AND REAPPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE SANDY SPRINGS BOARD OF ETHICS

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia (“City”) while in regular session on February 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. as follows:

SECTION 1. That Jonathan Levine, currently a regular member of the Board of Ethics, is hereby reappointed to the Board of Ethics for a second term of three (3) years ending on November 1, 2020; and

SECTION 2. That Kevin Rodriguez, currently an alternate member of the Board of Ethics, is hereby appointed to a first three-year term as a regular member of the Sandy Springs Board of Ethics (replacing Cindy Johnson); term ending on November 1, 2020; and


SECTION 3. That Gary Alexander is hereby appointed to a first three-year term on the Sandy Springs Board of Ethics as a first alternate; term ending on November 1, 2020; and

SECTION 4. That members and alternates of the Board of Ethics shall be eligible for reappointment upon nomination by the Mayor and confirmation by the City Council and shall not serve for more than two (2) consecutive terms when serving as a member, or two (2) consecutive terms when serving as an alternate; and

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.


