A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AWARD OF CONTRACT AND TASK ORDER IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY'S SOLICITATION FOR TENNIS CENTER OPERATON SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AND TASK ORDER

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs ("City") currently has a contract with Groslimond Tennis Services for tennis center operation services ("Contract") at the Sandy Springs Tennis Center ("Tennis Center"), which Contract will expire on June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the expiration of the Contract, the City issued a Request for Proposals for Tennis Center Operation Services ("RFP"), dated March 7, 2018, and received proposals from various vendors; and

WHEREAS, the proposals were evaluated by the Source Selection Evaluation Team ("SSET"), consistent with criteria established by the terms of the RFP, to determine the best overall value for the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, as the result of its evaluation, the SSET has provided its Source Evaluation Memorandum, in the form attached to this resolution, presenting the results of its evaluation for Tennis Center Operation Services and recommending: (a) a contract award to Groslimond Tennis Services; and (b) an award for the base year task order to Groslimond, beginning July I, 2018; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to make such awards based on the recommendations of the SSET consistent with the attached Source Evaluation Memorandum;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia while in regular session on May 15, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. as follows:

1. Groslimond Tennis Services is hereby awarded:
 - (a) a contract for Tennis Center Operation Services at the Tennis Center; and
 - (b) the first year task order for Tennis Center Operation Services at the Tennis Center, beginning July 1, 2018.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract and task order, and any other documents consistent with the above-referenced awards made in connection with the RFP for Tennis Center Operation Services, subject to approval of the City Attorney; and
3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take additional actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution, subject to approval of the City Attorney.


