A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AWARD OF CONTRACTS AND TASK ORDER IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY'S SOLICITATION FOR GENERAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES, MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs ("City") currently has a contract with a vendor for Municipal Court services ("Current Contract"), which will expire June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the expiration of the Current Contract, the City issued a Request for Proposals for General Government Services – Municipal Court Services, dated January 31, 2018 ("RFP"), and received proposals from various vendors; and

WHEREAS, the proposals were evaluated by the Source Selection Evaluation Team ("SSET"), consistent with criteria established by the terms of the RFP, to determine the best overall value for the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, as the result of its evaluation, the SSET has provided its Source Evaluation Memorandum, in the form attached to this resolution, presenting the results of its evaluation for Municipal Court Services and recommending: (a) a contract award to Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc.; and (b) a task order award to Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for the first year, beginning July 1, 2018, in the amount of \$821,310.00; and

WHEREAS, it is the City's intention, pursuant to the terms of the RFP, to award multiple indefinite-delivery, indefinite-quantity contracts for the delivery of all General Government Services, including Municipal Court Services, evaluating and identifying eligible contractors to compete for future task order awards under the terms of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to make such awards based on the recommendations of the SSET consistent with the attached Source Evaluation Memorandum.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia while in regular session on May 15, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. as follows:

1. Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. is hereby awarded:
 - (a) A contract for Municipal Court Services; and
 - (b) The first year task order for Municipal Court Services, beginning July 1, 2018, in the amount of \$821,310.00; and
2. In keeping with the City's intention to award multiple indefinite-delivery, indefinite-quantity contracts for the delivery of general government services, IBTS is hereby awarded a contract for Municipal Court Services, making it eligible to compete for future task order awards under the terms of the contract.
3. The City Manager and appropriate authorized City officials are hereby authorized to execute the contracts and task order for Municipal Court Services and to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.


