A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF CHAPTER 10, "ANIMALS," ARTICLE I, "IN GENERAL," AS PROVIDED FOR BY SEC. 10-18, "ANIMALS RESTRICTED ON CITY SPRINGS GREEN," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 10, Article I, Sec. 10-18 ("Ordinance") of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia ("Code"), civil penalties may be assessed against an individual who permits a dog or other domesticated or exotic animal/fowl, livestock or other wildlife on the City Springs Green; and

WHEREAS, it is important to enforce the Ordinance through civil penalties in order recoup the costs associated with cleanup and maintenance of the City Springs Green and to deter future violations; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides that violations shall be enforced through the assessment of civil penalties in amounts to be established by resolution of City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the imposition of the following fees in connection with violating the restriction on animals on the City Springs Green as provided in Sec. 10-18 of the Code.


Penalties against an individual who permits a dog or other domesticated or exotic animal/fowl, livestock or other wildlife on the City Springs Green:

This Resolution shall become effective on July 19, 2018.


