A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS AND THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE I-285 AT SR 400 INTERCHANGE RECONSTRUCTION AND COLLECTOR-DISTRIBUTOR PROJECT (PI #0013546)

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal and Georgia’s State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs (City) has represented to the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), a desire to improve the transportation facility described in Exhibit A, and a desire to participate in certain activities including the funding of certain portions of the project by constructing a proposed shared-use path; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted, the City of Sandy Springs (City) has entered into an Amended Memorandum of Understanding with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT); and

WHEREAS, the City has represented to GDOT a desire to amend the original Memorandum of Understanding to participate in Designing and Constructing replacement of the I-285 mainline structure and associated collector distributor structures over Glenridge Drive and Peachtree Dunwoody Road as part of the project at the aforesaid location, and GDOT has relied upon such representation; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Amended Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with GDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA


