**A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT OF ENTIRE BUILDING RENOVATION OR RECONSTRUCTION FOR THE SANDY SPRINGS LIBRARY**

**WHEREAS**, The Sandy Springs Public Library was built in 1973; and

**WHEREAS**, The Sandy Springs Public Library serves a community with a population of more than 106,739, which is the second largest municipal population in the metro Atlanta area; and

**WHEREAS**, The Sandy Springs Public Library is the only library serving the residents of Fulton County in the city of Sandy Springs, where typically, cities of this size are served by at least two public libraries; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Sandy Springs has invested heavily in the area where the Sandy Springs Library is situated, with a goal of making the area more walkable, with wide, multi-use paths and enhanced greenspace. The City Springs complex opened in August 2018, including city hall, a performing arts center, a four-acre park, and residential facilities. Additional programs to enhance the sidewalk and streetscape are underway through the City's T-SPLOST program; and


**WHEREAS**, Other cities have received new facilities for buildings which are more than ten years younger than the Sandy Springs Library.

That the City Council supports exterior renovation, in addition to the already approved interior renovation or reconstruction of the Sandy Springs Library.


