RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND APPROVE THE PROPOSED SUBMISSION OF  
STREETS TO BE RESURFACED WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION FISCAL YEAR 2019 LOCAL MAINTENANCE AND  
IMPROVEMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, will apply for a grant from the Georgia Department of Transportation based on a list of roads approved by the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will incorporate the maintenance of the resurfaced roads into the City's pavement management program to effectuate the management of Department of Public Works policy.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA**

That they have reviewed and approved the submission of streets to the Georgia Department of Transportation's FY 2019 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) program and authorize the Public Works Department to submit the list on behalf of the City.

The financial impact to the City will be the 30% required match of \$271,934.25, plus any funds that may be above and beyond that amount to complete the submitted list.


