**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS 2020 AMENDMENT TO THE 2018-2022 CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR SUBMISSION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, since 1974 the Community Development Block Grant Program has been an important Federal resource for cities and counties to principally benefit their low- and moderate-income communities, eliminate slums and blight, and address urgent needs in support of local government efforts to develop viable urban communities and stable neighborhoods; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs was notified by HUD of the City's qualification as an CDBG Entitlement Community on October 1, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, the City held a public hearing for the purposes of soliciting public regarding the 2020 Amendment to the Consolidated Plan on May 7, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Amendment to the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan was advertised for a 5-day public comment period from May 7, 2020 to May 12, 2020 to solicit final comments on these documents prior to adoption by Mayor and City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Amendment to the Consolidated Plan is due to HUD to qualify to participate in the 2020 CDBG Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL.**

By passage of this resolution, the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council authorizes submission of the 2020 Amendment to the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan, and an original copy of this resolution, to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the purposes of participating in the Community Development Block Grant Program.
