**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs is built out and requires innovative methods to accommodate the increasing number of vehicles and users of alternative modes in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs has made significant investment in ITS infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to identify a means to continue to optimize the existing transportation system by integrating technology to manage, operate and enhance the travel experience.
