**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A PLANNING GRANT APPLICATION
TO THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION FOR THE 2019 REGIONAL
TRANSPORTATION PLAN, TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
AND MAKE A COMMITMENT FOR LOCAL FUNDING MATCH**

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs' adopted Transportation Master Plan; Roswell Road Livable Initiative Study; the City Center Master Plan, Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trail Plan; The Next 10 Comprehensive Plan; and Roswell Road Small Area Plan include high level access management guidance for Roswell Road; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to identify treatments at specific locations along the Roswell Road corridor and a plan to implement them; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Commission identifies the corridor as regionally significant; is a major north/south corridor, has average daily traffic volumes of 31,000 to 38,000 vehicles per day, serves highly used MARTA bus stops, and has some of the highest crash rates within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) supports the City of Sandy Springs' application to the Atlanta Regional Commission for the proposed project.




