**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT APPLICATION  
TO THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION FOR THE 2019 REGIONAL  
TRANSPORTATION PLAN, TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM  
AND MAKE A COMMITMENT FOR LOCAL FUNDING MATCH**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs' adopted Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trail Plan; The Next 10 Comprehensive Plan; and Perimeter Center Small Area Plan have recommended a bicycle and pedestrian multi-use trail adjacent to State Route (SR) 400; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs initiated the Transportation Special Purpose Local Option Sales Project TS201, SR 400 Multiuse Path, in 2016 to provide preliminary funding for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta plans to construct a multiuse path between the City of Sandy Springs and the proposed PATH 400 Trail at Loridans Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, the expansion of the PATH 400 network is a high regional priority to provide alternative transportation in the GA 400 corridor, businesses, schools, and MARTA Bus Route 5 bus stops.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA**

That they approve the submittal of an application to the Atlanta Regional Commission for the 2019 Regional Transportation Plan, Transportation Improvement Program Project Solicitation for the SR 400 Multi-Use Trail project.

Commits to providing local matching funding of 20 percent of up to \$3,844,826.00, for a federal grant match of up to \$15,379,304.00 (80 percent) for a total of \$19,224,130.00 for project implementation.
