**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE CITY OF DUNWOODY, GEORGIA TO INSTALL SIGNAL DETECTION DEVICES WITHIN THE CITY OF DUNWOODY AS PART OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA TS107 - ATMS 4 SCOOT IMPLEMENTATION IN THE PERIMETER AREA PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal and Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the Interim City Manager, has reviewed and recommends the Mayor signing the following Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Sandy Springs and the City of Dunwoody; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

**WHEREAS**, upon adoption of this Resolution, City Sandy Springs Public Works Department staff will manage all applicable phases of the Agreement in conjunction with the City of Dunwoody staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA**


