**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AWARD OF CONTRACT IN CONNECTION
WITH THE TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs Public Works Department is charged with developing transportation plans, providing analysis for future transportation needs, and providing a long-term vision for capital investment in the City's transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs current Transportation Master Plan was developed in 2008 and the City is undergoing many changes which need to be addressed in an updated transportation plan; and

WHEREAS, in order to advance this goal, the City issued its Request for Proposals ("RFP") for the Sandy Springs Transportation Master Plan, seeking to identify a highly qualified firm to provide personnel, materials and services necessary to develop an implementable Transportation Master Plan ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City received five (5) submittals in response to the RFP ("Proposals"); and

WHEREAS, Proposals were evaluated by an evaluation committee made up of City staff, ("Evaluation Committee"), consistent with criteria established by the terms of the RFP, to determine the Proposal representing the best overall value for the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee has provided its Evaluation Memorandum, in the form attached to this resolution, presenting the results of its evaluation and recommending contract award to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$350,000; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to make an award based on the recommendations of the Evaluation Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA

Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. is hereby awarded a contract for The Transportation Master Plan, in the amount of \$350,000.00 subject to approval of the City Attorney and the City Finance Director, the Interim City Manager and appropriate authorized City officials are hereby authorized to execute a contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., for the Transportation Master Plan and to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.


