**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2019 SANDY SPRINGS
TRAIL MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs (“City”) is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia, and is charged with providing public services to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Next Ten Comprehensive Plan and the Recreation and Parks Master Plan identify hiking and multi-use trails as priorities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Recreation and Cultural Enhancement as a priority, which includes completing the Trail Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City partnered with the Sandy Springs Conservancy, which provided partial funding for the plan; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held on June 19, 2019 to solicit public feedback; and

WHEREAS, the PATH Foundation and Kaizen Collaborative prepared a draft Trail Master Plan (“Master Plan”) and Implementation Strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Master Plan, if approved, will serve as a blue print to guide future capital program priorities; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to adopt the Master Plan as finalized and as attached to this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby adopts the Master Plan as attached to this resolution.
2. The City Council authorizes the Interim City Manager and staff to proceed with the necessary steps subsequent to the adoption of the Master Plan with the goal of implementing the Trail Master Plan as attached to this resolution.
3. The City Council authorizes the Interim City Manager to make such minor changes to the Master Plan as may be necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution, subject to approval of the City Attorney.

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4. The City Council authorizes the Interim City Manager to execute any documents and to take any other steps which may be necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.


