**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO THE EXISTING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH GWINNETT COUNTY TO INCLUDE A SIDEWALK ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF SPALDING DRIVE WITHIN A ROADWAY WIDENING PROJECT FROM WINTERS CHAPEL ROAD TO HOLCOMB BRIDGE ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal and Georgia’s State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has reviewed and recommends the Mayor signing the following Revised Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Sandy Springs and Gwinnett County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and



Receive, accept, and affirm the authorization for the Mayor to sign the Change Order No. 1 to the Intergovernmental Agreement with Gwinnett County, previously approved on October 2, 2018, to include a sidewalk along the north side of Spalding Drive within a roadway widening project from Winters Chapel Road to Holcomb Bridge Road that is being executed by Gwinnett County.
