RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, TO APPROVE PARTICIPATION IN THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION – ATLANTA MAJOR OFFENDERS VIOLENT CRIME TASK FORCE AND SAFE STREETS GANG TASK FORCE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER AND POLICE CHIEF TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTATION TO EFFECTUATE THE SAME

WHEREAS, the City currently has in place a Memorandum of Understanding with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (“FBI”) regarding participation in the Atlanta Metropolitan Major Offenders Violent Crime Task Force (“Violent Crime Task Force”); and

WHEREAS, in December of 2019, the FBI merged the Violent Crime Task Force with the Safe Streets Gang Task Force (together referred to as “Combined Task Force”); and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that continuing this relationship with the FBI and entering into new Memorandum(s) of Understanding (“MOU(s)”) to participate in the Combined Task Force is in the best interest of the general public and the citizens of the City; and


WHEREAS, the new MOU(s) will replace and supersede the MOU currently in place for the Violent Crime Task Force executed by the City in 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia, while in regular session on August 4, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., that:

1. The City Manager and the Police Chief are hereby authorized to participate in the Combined Task Force by entering into new Memorandum(s) of Understanding with the FBI upon such terms and conditions deemed appropriate by the City Manager and the Police Chief, subject to approval of the City Attorney; and
2. The City Manager and the Police Chief are hereby authorized to enter into such other documentation as may be required to effectuate participation in the Combined Task Force, subject to approval of the City Attorney; and
3. The City Manager and the Police Chief are hereby authorized to take such actions as may be deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
