**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN SOLIDARITY SANDY SPRINGS, INC. AND THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, FOR THE SOLIDARITY SANDY SPRINGS FOOD PANTRY PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the mission of Solidarity Sandy Springs (“Organization”) is to provide food to insecure families in the City of Sandy Springs (“City”) affected by the current COVID-19 pandemic (“Pandemic”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Organization serves many persons in the City and enhances the City by providing valuable and critical services for those in need; and

**WHEREAS**, in consideration of the Organization’s mission and the services it provides for the City, the City wishes to assist the Organization, particularly during the Pandemic, by providing a \$25,000 grant to the Organization (“Grant”) to conduct its mission throughout the following year; and


**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) attached hereto, providing the terms, conditions and responsibilities of the parties with respect to the Grant.

3. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to make such minor revisions to the MOU as may be deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
