A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR LICENSES AND PERMITS FOR VEHICLE IMMOBILIZATION SERVICES AND OPERATORS, AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 58, "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES," ARTICLE IV, "VEHICLE IMMOBILIZATION SERVICE," SECTION 58-92, "APPLICATION, LICENSE AND PERMIT FEES," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 58, Article IV, Section 58-86, et seq. ("Ordinance") of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia ("Code"), an application may be filed seeking a license to operate a vehicle immobilization service in the City of Sandy Springs ("City"), and to obtain a permit to operate as an operator of a vehicle immobilization service, all as set forth in that section; and

WHEREAS, Section 58-92 of the Code provides that in order to obtain such a license or permit, an applicant shall pay such fees when submitting an application or renewal request as set by resolution of the city council; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain a license or permit under the Ordinance, the applicant seeking such a license or permit must undergo a background check or background checks;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the imposition of the following fees in connection with the application for a license or permit pursuant to Section 58-92 of the Code:

(a) A nonrefundable application fee in the amount of \$100.00, which fee shall accompany any application for a vehicle immobilization service license submitted pursuant to Section 58-88 of the Code; and

(b) A nonrefundable application fee in the amount of \$25.00, which fee shall accompany any application for an operator's permit submitted pursuant to Section 58-89 of the Code; and

(c) A nonrefundable fee in the amount of \$50.00 for a background check for each person applying for a vehicle immobilization service license or operator's permit, which fee shall accompany any application submitted pursuant to Sections 58-88 and 58-89 of the Code; and

(d) An annual license fee in the amount of \$500.00 upon approval of an application for a vehicle immobilization service license; and

(e) An annual permit fee in the amount of \$50.00 upon approval of an application for an operator's permit; and

(f) An annual fee in the amount of \$50.00 for a background check for each person approved for a vehicle immobilization service license or operator's permit.

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2. The City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council hereby establish the following amounts as fees that may be charged by a vehicle immobilization service registered and authorized in the City of Sandy Springs for the removal of the vehicle immobilization device or devices or the release from impoundment:

<u>Classification</u>	<u>Authorized Fee</u>
Vehicles with a GVWR of 10,000 pounds or less	\$ 75.00
Vehicles with a GVWR of 10,001 – 20,000 pounds	\$150.00
Semi-trucks without a trailer with a GVWR of 20,001 pounds or greater	\$300.00
Combination units with a combined GVWR of 20,001 pounds or greater	\$450.00

As used in this paragraph 2, the following terms have the meanings ascribed to them below:

(a) *Combination Unit* means a semi-truck connected to a trailer or trailers with a combined GVWR greater than 20,000.

(b) *GVWR* (gross vehicle weight rating) means the value specified by the manufacturer as the loaded weight of a single vehicle.


(c) *Semi-truck* means any truck that uses a connecting device to connect the truck to a trailer or multiple trailers.

(d) *Trailer* means every vehicle with or without motive power designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor vehicle and so constructed that no part of its weight rests upon the towing vehicle.


(e) *Truck* means every motor vehicle designed, used, or maintained primarily for the transportation of property.
