RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND APPROVE THE PROPOSED SUBMISSION OF STREETS TO BE RESURFACED WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FISCAL YEAR 2013 LOCAL MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has applied for and received a grant from the Georgia Department of Transportation based on a list of roads submitted that were approved by the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will incorporate the maintenance of the resurfaced roads into the City's pavement management program to effectuate the management of Department of Public Works policy; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA

Have reviewed and approved the list of roads to be submitted to the Georgia Department of Transportation's FY 2013 Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) and authorize the Public Works Department to submit the list on behalf of the City.

There is no financial impact to the City for the submission of the list.


