**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO CONDEMN THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT DALRYMPLE ROAD THROUGH THE USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN OF THE DALRYMPLE ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT, IN LAND LOT 32 OF THE 17th DISTRICT, CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has reviewed and approves the use of Eminent Domain by the City of Sandy Springs for the property located on Parcel 6 of the Peachtree Dunwoody Road Project, in Land Lot 32 of the 17<sup>th</sup> District, City of Sandy Springs, Fulton County, Georgia, owned by the Sutton Pines Condominium Association, Inc.

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, the City Attorney will proceed with the steps required to utilize eminent domain;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA,**

That they authorize the use of Eminent Domain on the property located on Dalrymple Road of the Dalrymple Road Sidewalk Project, in Land Lot 32 of the 17<sup>th</sup> District, for the purpose of road and sidewalk improvements.
