**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF THE TEMPORARY AND PERMANENT CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND UTILITY EASEMENTS ON PROPERTY LOCATED ON LAND LOT 18 OF THE 17TH DISTRICT, CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has reviewed and approves the donation of and acceptance by the City of Sandy Springs temporary construction easement rights on Land Lot 18 of the 17<sup>th</sup> District, City of Sandy Springs, Fulton County, Georgia owned by CRP Holdings V, L.P., and

**WHEREAS**, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will incorporate the maintenance of the acquired property into the City's management program to effectuate the management of Department of Public Works' Right-of-Way policy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA**

That the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council approve the acceptance of the temporary construction and permanent construction, maintenance, and utility easement on Land Lot 18 of the 17<sup>th</sup> District, which is owned by CRP Holdings V, L.P.

To facilitate the PCID Peachtree Dunwoody Road LCI Streetscape Project, the City authorizes the requested Temporary and Permanent Construction, Maintenance, and Utility Easements located on Land Lot 18 of the 17<sup>th</sup> District, City of Sandy Springs, Fulton County, Georgia.
