**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY ON PROPERTY LOCATED
ON LAND LOT 131 AND 165 OF THE 17TH DISTRICT, CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS,
FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has reviewed and approves the donation of and acceptance by the City of Sandy Springs permanent construction, maintenance, and utility easement and temporary construction easement rights on Land Lot 19 of the 17th District, City of Sandy Springs, Fulton County, Georgia owned by Edward and Peni Groote, and Christopher and Angela Sanders, and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will incorporate the maintenance of the acquired property into the City's management program to effectuate the management of Department of Public Works' Right-of-Way policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA

That the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council approve the acceptance of the permanent construction, maintenance, and utility easement and temporary construction easement rights on Land Lot 19 of the 17th District, which is owned by Edward and Peni Groote, and Christopher and Angela Sanders.

It is further affirmed that the property is being donated to the City by the property owner, and there is no financial impact to the City of Sandy Springs, other than the costs related to the recording the documents and the maintenance of the City's right-of-way.


