A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ECODRIVING TECHNIQUES

WHEREAS, the use of sensible driving techniques can save millions of barrels in imported oil each year allowing American businesses, families and communities to reinvest those resources here at home, and;

WHEREAS, EcoDriving USA is a nationwide effort to increase overall vehicle fuel economy and preserve the environment in which we live, and;

WHEREAS, nationally if half of all drivers across the U.S. practiced EcoDriving techniques, annual CO₂ emissions could be reduced by about 100 million tons – the equivalent of heating and powering 8.5 million homes, and;

WHEREAS, Georgia is one of seven states to joint the national effort to promote EcoDriving.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the City of Sandy Springs supports EcoDriving techniques and urge our Sandy Springs residents to adopt EcoDriving techniques to reduce the amount of energy consumption in our community, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Sandy Springs thanks Gov. Perdue for being only one of seven governors nationwide to enroll Georgia in this significant energy conservation effort.


