A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE AWARD OF CONTRACT NO. T-3000 TO BLOUNT CONSTRUCTION CO., INC., AS PART OF THE 2010 CAPITAL RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has prepared the list of streets for reconstruction as provided in the 2010 Capital Reconstruction Map of Streets of The City of Sandy Springs, Fulton County, Georgia, and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, staff will incorporate the maintenance of the reconstructed streets into the City's Pavement Management Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA,

Have reviewed and approved the award of the contract to the selected Contractor, Blount Construction Co., Inc. and execution of the contract documents by the City Manager.


The financial impact to the City of Sandy Springs for the approval of the 2010 Capital Reconstruction Program Contract Bid No. is \$1,281,091.00. In addition to the prepared list of streets provided in the 2010 Capital Reconstruction Map of Streets of The City of Sandy Springs, Fulton County, Georgia, the City Manager may add additional streets to the contract for reconstruction not to exceed currently approved funding for the City's pavement management program, in accordance with established Public Works guidelines. A budget allowance for material testing associated with 2010 Capital Reconstruction Program contract T-3000 09-208A is \$30,000.
