WHEREAS, the Anne Frank in the World: 1929-1945 Exhibit is an internationally acclaimed, award-winning exhibit incorporating over 600 photographs and 8,000 words of text to tell the story of Anne Frank; and

WHEREAS, the Exhibit is a powerful vehicle for teaching about the causes, instruments and dangers of discrimination and racism, and of the dangerous consequences spawned by hate, violence and brutality; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Springs has the opportunity to host the Exhibit for a minimum of three years from the date of the relocation; and

WHEREAS, the Exhibit will provide for promotion of tourism and provide a significant positive economic impact to the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the Exhibit will be a valuable addition to the community providing education, enrichment and enhancing the cultural fabric of the City of Sandy Springs, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the business community, and community at large, has shown support for the relocation of the Exhibit within the City through both in-kind and financial donations and commitments; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes and supports the relocation of the Exhibit as a benefit to the citizens of the City as well as the State of Georgia;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that:

The City of Sandy Springs, Georgia supports the relocation of the Anne Frank in the World: 1929-1945 Exhibit to the City and looks forward to this valuable addition to the community.

The City Manager is authorized to execute the Letter of Intent regarding the City's support and commitment for the relocation of the Exhibit to the City.


