**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE USE OF EXISTING EARMARK FUNDS FOR A SHORT TERM ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ON THE ROSWELL ROAD BRIDGE OVER I-285 AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ENGINEERING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS WITH ARCADIS**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines addressing the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council wish to authorize the Public Works staff to utilize the existing earmark funding associated with the Georgia Department of Transportation P.I. Numbers 9159 and 9160 in the amount of \$1,602,000 to pursue the short term roadway improvement project of adding one lane to the existing bridge on Roswell Road over I-285. Local match funding in the amount of \$400,500 will be authorized for this project using Capital Improvement Program funding.

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into an Agreement with GDOT for the execution of construction of the referenced project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into an Agreement with Arcadis for engineering and related support of the referenced project; and

**WHEREAS**, upon adoption of this Resolution, City Sandy Springs Public Works Department staff will manage all applicable phases of the project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA**

That they hereby authorize the Public Works staff to utilize the existing earmark funding to pursue the short term roadway improvement project, and


