A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO GRANT TEMPORARY STATE ROUTE STATUS TO HAMMOND DRIVE AND SANDY SPRINGS CIRCLE AND TO REPROGRAM CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS FROM T-0014 TO T-0006

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines addressing the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs,

WHEREAS, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to authorize the Public Works staff to request the Georgia Department of Transportation grant temporary State Route status to Hammond Drive and Sandy Springs Circle, as a means of facilitating right-of-way acquisitions for the construction of road improvements, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to reprogram Capital Improvement Program funds from T-0014 (Sandy Springs Circle Pedestrian Improvements – Phase II) to T-0006 (Sandy Springs Circle and Hammond Drive Pedestrian Improvements) as needed, not to exceed \$190,000, as local funds to provide local match and fund local actions in conjunction with this project, and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, City Sandy Springs Public Works Department staff will manage all applicable phases of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA

That they hereby authorize the Public Works staff to request the Georgia Department of Transportation grant temporary State Route status to Hammond Drive and Sandy Springs Circle.


