**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S
(GDOT) STATE ROUTE DESIGNATION FOR HAMMOND DRIVE AND SANDY SPRINGS
CIRCLE, CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines addressing the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager directed the Department of Public Works to develop standard policies for recurring matters, to establish appropriate internal controls and legal compliance, and to provide for an efficient and effective means to serve constituents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the city of Sandy Springs (hereinafter called the City) was notified that sections of Sandy Springs Circle and Hammond Drive are being added to the State Highway System as State Routes 1218 and 1218TA by an Order of the Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Transportation (hereinafter called the Department) as shown on the attached sketch map 3536M, and

WHEREAS, the City and the Department agree that it is in the public interest and in the interest of all parties hereto, for the City and the Department to enter into a contract numbered 3536M wherein the City will agree to fully maintain the aforementioned roadways while designated as State Routes 1218 and 1218TA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA

That the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council accept the Georgia Department of Transportation's State Route Designation for Hammond Drive and Sandy Springs Circle.


