A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A CONTRACT ADDENDUM FOR STORMWATER INVENTORY SERVICES WITH THE SELECTED CONTRACTOR, ARCADIS, AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has contacted the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) National Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) regarding their Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) Program, and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2009, flooding from the intense rainstorms caused extensive damage to the stormwater sewer system of the City, and

WHEREAS, Congress has authorized the USDA NRCS to respond to watershed disasters by directing technical and financial assistance to landowners and administering funds through the EWP Program, and

WHEREAS, the EWP program is designed to relieve imminent hazards to life and property caused by floods, and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, City Sandy Springs Public Works Department staff will manage all applicable phases of the EWP program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA


That the Mayor and City Council hereby approve the participation of the City in the EWP Program and authorize the City Manager to process the contract documents and funding.
