**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS'**  
**FEE SCHEDULE PERTAINING TO ADULT ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT FEES**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 2006-07-63 (the "Resolution") of the City Council of the City of Sandy Springs (the "City"), adopted July 5, 2006, the City established certain fees relating to employees and independent contractors who work for adult entertainment establishments, including permit fees for new employees, permit renewal fees and background investigation fees (such fees collectively referred to as the "Fees"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Fees were set by Fulton County prior to incorporation of the City and the City adopted the Fees upon incorporation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fees as set by Fulton County and adopted pursuant to the Resolution are as follows: permit fee – new employees - \$300; background investigation fee - \$50; permit fee – renewal - \$50. The Fees resulted in a charge to new employees of \$350 (permit fee and background check fee) and a charge for renewal of \$100 (\$50 renewal fee and \$50 background check fee); and

**WHEREAS**, the City recently conducted an adult entertainment permit fee analysis (the "Cost Analysis") to determine whether the Fees set by Fulton County are appropriate for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the Cost Analysis, the City now desires to amend the fee schedule set by Fulton County and adopted by the City pursuant to the Resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:


1. The fee schedule adopted by City Council pursuant to the Resolution shall be amended to provide that the permit fee – new employees, permit fee – renewal, and background investigation fee shall be as follows:

Permit Fee – New Employees	\$55
Permit Fee – Renewal	\$55
Background Investigation Fee	\$0


2. The fee schedule shall be amended only as specifically provided in this resolution and shall not affect any other fees adopted by City Council heretofore.
3. This amendment shall be effective the date of its adoption.
