**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A CONTRACT FOR DR-1858 HMGP APPLICATION WITH
THE SELECTED CONTRACTOR, MANHARD CONSULTING, INC. , AND AUTHORIZE THE
CITY MANAGER TO SIGN**

WHEREAS, it is necessary, from time to time, to establish policies, procedures and guidelines consistent with the administration of a municipal government consistent with the US Constitution, Federal Statutes, alignment with Federal, Georgia's State Constitution, and the Charter for the City of Sandy Springs and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, in response to the guidance provided by the City Manager, has contacted the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regarding their Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2009, flooding from the intense rainstorms caused extensive damage to the city infrastructure and devastating flooding and damage for several citizens, and

WHEREAS, Federal disaster DR-1858 was declared and Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funding is now available, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the HMGP is to provide funds to State agencies and local governments in the aftermath of a disaster for projects that reduce or eliminate the long-term risk to human life and property from the effect of natural hazards, and


WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Resolution, City Sandy Springs Public Works Department staff will manage all applicable phases of the HMGP application contract.

CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA**


