

A RESOLUTION URGING THE FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADHERE TO THE ORIGINAL PLAN AS PRESENTED TO THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL AND OUR CONSTITUENTS BOTH IN THE FACILITIES TO BE CONSTRUCTED AND IN THE TIMING OF CONSTRUCTION OF THOSE FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Fulton County School System came before the voters and residents of Fulton County, including the residents of Sandy Springs, requesting a Special Option Local Sales Tax for the purpose of building new schools and educational facilities for the children of Fulton County, and;

WHEREAS, certain representations were made to the voters about the facilities and the timing of said facilities that would serve the children of Sandy Springs, including new elementary schools at Lake Forrest Drive and Isom Road, and;

WHEREAS, the Fulton County School Board asked the City of Sandy Springs to pass a resolution encouraging the residents of Sandy Springs to support and vote in favor of the Special Local Option Sales Tax, and;


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council went on record in support of the Special Local Option Sales Tax based on certain representations about the facilities and timing of construction of said facilities made by the Fulton County School System, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of Sandy Springs acted in good faith that the Fulton County School System would implement the plan as presented to it and to its citizens.


