

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE REIMBURSEMENT OF FEES AND EXPENSES ADVANCED IN CONNECTION WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A 9-1-1 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE TO SERVE THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS AND THE CITY OF JOHNS CREEK

WHEREAS, 9-1-1 communications for the City of Sandy Springs (the "City"), including police and fire dispatch operations, are currently provided by the Fulton County Department of Emergency Services ("Fulton County") pursuant to contract scheduled to terminate on December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the termination of the contract with Fulton County, the City has been working with the City of Johns Creek to explore the possibility of forming a multi-jurisdictional 9-1-1 system (the "Project") as allowed by O.C.G.A. § 46-5-125; and

WHEREAS, in order to proceed with a comprehensive analysis and evaluation of all existing infrastructure and technological needs for the Project, the City will require the professional services of an experienced consulting firm with a broad base of expertise in areas critical to the Project and will incur certain fees and expenses related thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City expects to be Project lead and to advance its own funds to pay such fees and expenses, in whole or in part, prior to the implementation of the Project and prior to the collection of any monthly 9-1-1 telephone subscriber charges as provided in O.C.G.A. § 46-5-133;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, that should the Project be implemented as anticipated, and should the City advance its own funds to pay fees and expenses to utilize professionals or incur other fees and expenses in connection with a comprehensive analysis and evaluation of existing infrastructure and technological needs for the Project, the City shall be reimbursed for fees and expenses so advanced to benefit the Project, from the fund established by the City for monthly 9-1-1 charges, as allowed by Georgia law.


