

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO WAIVE ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA RELATED TO BANNERS FROM THE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION TO JANUARY 1, 2009

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are the governing authority of the City of Sandy Springs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to allow the residents and businesses located within the City of Sandy Springs to more liberally utilize banners during the period between the date of this resolution and January 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are aware of the current economic conditions and its effect on businesses within the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL.

By passage of this resolution, the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council express concern for businesses within the City due to current economic conditions, and hereby direct staff to waive enforcement of the provisions of the Official Code of Sandy Springs, Georgia related to the permitting, but not the size and location of Banners from the date of this resolution to January 1, 2009.
