

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE CITY OF SANDY
SPRINGS SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A §12-8-31.1 gives the Georgia Department of Community Affairs authority to establish procedural standards for use in the preparation, submittal, review, adoption, update and amendment of local, multi-jurisdictional and regional solid waste management plans; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act established a deadline for complying with the Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Solid Waste Management; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs shall maintain the official list of governments that are eligible for municipal solid waste disposal facility and/or solid waste handling facility **or** recycling grants, loans and permits based on their compliance with these standards, and shall regularly update the list; and

WHEREAS, local governments shall prepare, maintain and update, submit for review and subsequently adopt a solid waste management plan that meets the Minimum Standards and Procedures approximately every ten years in accordance with a schedule established by the Department of Community Affairs; and

WHEREAS, local governments shall prepare, maintain and update, submit for review, and subsequently adopt a Short-term Work Program that meets the Minimum Standards and Procedures approximately every five years in accordance with a schedule established by the Department of Community Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the submitting local government, or governments for multi-jurisdictional or regional plans, must take official action, by resolution, authorizing the transmittal of the draft solid waste management plan to the Regional Development Center for review and certifying that the minimum public participation requirements have been met; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Development Center shall review solid waste management plans for internal consistencies and potential inter-jurisdictional conflicts or conflicts with other local government plans in the region, including but not limited to the local government Comprehensive Plan(s) and the State solid waste management plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL.

By passage of this resolution, the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council authorize transmittal of the Sandy Springs Solid Waste Management Plan to the Atlanta Regional Commission for determination as to the plan's compliance with Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Solid Waste Management.


