**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND REQUESTING THE INTRODUCTION OF  
LEGISLATION INTO THE 2006 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO FACILITATE THE CREATION  
OF A REVENUE STREAM ATTACHED TO MUNICIPAL COURT FEES DEDICATED TO  
PROVIDING RESOURCES FOR PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandy Springs is committed to maintaining services and amenities previously provided by Fulton County to its residents, and expanding such services when needs are justified; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety is a significant priority of the Mayor and City Council of City of Sandy Springs; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to provide a funding mechanism for public safety facilities; and


**WHEREAS**, such funding mechanism would be attached to the users of the public safety system through a fee associated with a Municipal Court citation.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA, AND IT IS RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAID CITY COUNCIL.

By passage of this resolution, the City of Sandy Springs Mayor and City Council authorizes the City Attorney to introduce legislation into the 2006 Georgia General Assembly to create a revenue stream attached to municipal court fees dedicated to providing resources for public safety facilities.
